Course Descriptions

Course specifics will be designed by the trial committee the day of the trial and may change from run to run.

Course 1 – Driving course – Handler will remain at the handler's post for the majority of the course. Skills may include, serpentine or dogleg fetches, free standing obstacles (panels/Y-chute), fence obstacles (Y-chute, Z-chute, L-chute, bridge) and a pen or trailer load.

Course 2 – Close at hand course – Handler and dog will work a number of obstacles with the handler being able to move to the obstacles. Skills may include, serpentine or dogleg fetches, driving, Y-chute, Z-chute, L-chute, Foot bath, bridge, Maltese Cross, and a pen or trailer load.
